The **Wastewater Technician** is primarily responsible to support daily operations of the water distribution system, wastewater treatment plant and other key utility duties and responsibilities including, but not limited to:

- Perform maintenance and repairs of broken water, sewer and sewer force main lines including locating and isolation of valves, identifying and repairing leaks, replacing pipes making necessary connections
