Town of New Glasgow Water Utility WATER TREATMENT PLANT OPERATOR/FACILITY TECHNICIAN

The Town of New Glasgow Water Utility is currently seeking a competent Water Treatment Operator to join its team at the Water Treatment Plant at Forbes Lake. Working under the supervision of the Water Treatment and Supply Manager, the applicant's main responsibilities will be to operate and maintain the dissolved air floatation (DAF) Water Treatment Plant and its distribution system stations and reservoirs. Department of Environment (NSE) Operator Certification will be required to work within the Water Utility.

Applicants must have successfully completed a two (2) year certification program as an electro-mechanical technician or equivalent type program. Candidates must also have a minimum of three (3) years' experience in the electrical/mechanical/instrumentation maintenance field, preferably in the potable water industry. Candidates must possess a Valid Nova Scotia Driver's License Class 5, a clean driver's abstract, valid WHMIS, valid first aid training, and preferred qualifications of Level I (or higher) Operator Certification for Water Distribution and Water Treatment.

This is a physically demanding job in which overtime work will be required to meet the needs of our customers. This position is a permanent classification with a probation period of six months, as per the Collective Agreement. This is a unionized position, with remuneration as per the Collective Agreement between the Town of New Glasgow and CUPE Local 281.
