10. Equipment acquisition	Learn types and relevancy of safety equipment required, inventory existing equipment and methods of application
11. Education & Training	Understand the importance of record keeping, personnel education and methods of training
12. Establish rescue plans & drills	Develop rescue plans and understand rescue capabilities including in-house practice drills
13. Summary and conclusion	Review CSE program findings and discussion regarding
