Understanding System Hydraulics August 3-4, 2021 (8:30 – 12:30 AST)

Course Objective / Description

The objective of this course is to better understand how distribution or collection systems work, and in order to do that, a basic understanding of hydraulics is essential. This course will allow operators to better understand how water moves through pipes and how pressure size and biofilm can affect system operations. It contains information on potential and kinetic energy within these systems, how the amount of energy at any point can be determined, and how we use that energy to distribute water. Students will also gain a clear understanding of simple math calculations as they relate to day to day operations.

What will be covered:

- How is pressure created in a water system
- Pressure and its affect on flow in service pipes
- Flow and its affect on pressure in pipes
- Pressure as it relates to backflow and backsiphonage
- Restoring diminished flows
